CompleteCare Program

- All maintenance needed on a 2, 4, 8 or 12 week basis, depending upon production levels.
- Extended Warranty for the duration of the CompleteCare Program. (Does not cover VFD's and Fire Suppression reloading.)
- All equipment repairs, if completed at time of maintenance.
- Typical maintenance procedure
 - 1) Stop blower, reset digital read-out to zero, restart blower, record Δ -P value.
 - 2) Stop blower, set controller to rapid pulse, pulse down for 30-60 minutes.
 - 3) Start blower, record new Δ -P value.
 - 4) Inspect system.
 - 5) Check for blower/motor vibrations.
 - 6) Check pulse valves
 - 7) Check controller function.
 - 8) Replace parts as necessary.
 - 9) Record estimated volume of collected fume particles.
 - 10) Empty dust tray.
 - 11) Clean system's spark arrestant baffle filters or replace with clean baffle filters.
 - 12) Change cartridge filters as required.
 - 13) Record filter pressure and filter life.

CompleteCare with Filters

- Includes all above CompleteCare Program.
- Filters as a monthly cost included in the cost of Maintenance.
- No additional costs except neglect and VFD replacement.
